- Annotations by students and instructors – separately or together?
- Licensing and distribution issues; roles of schools/MITP?

## Authoring and Evolution

- The original authoring approach and the resulting book architecture will continue to guide the evolution of the book
- “Area editors” (1:many with endnote categories)
  - Add new endnotes, sidebars, or other supplemental content
  - Extract / subtract content currently in the core and make it an endnote
  - Create case studies, appendices, assignments, exam questions in their area

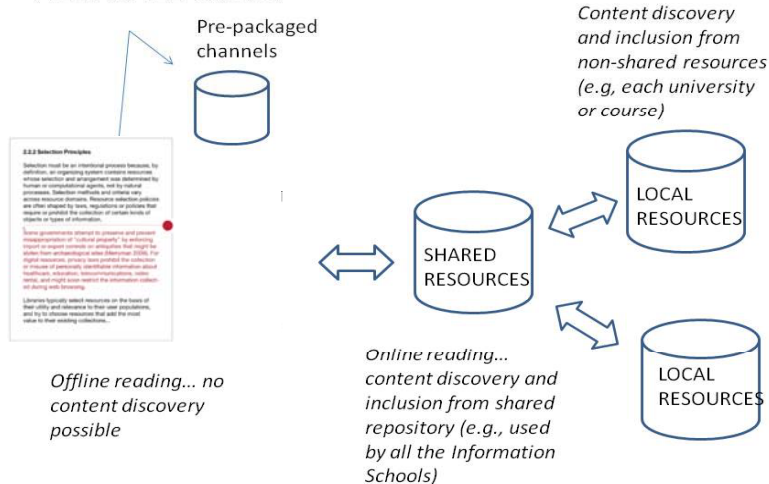
## Strawman Plan
